

## Small knitted star

You will need;

a small quantity of DK yarn – any colour of your choice  
a pair of 3.25mm needles

### Abbreviations

k – knit

k3tog – knit three stitched together

p – purl

p3tog – purl three stitches together

WS – wrong side

### Pattern

Cast on 57 stitches using the thumb method

Row 1 (WS) – knit

Row 2 - k5, \*k3tog, k8\* repeat from \* to \* around to last 8 stitches, k3tog, k5 (47 stitches)

Row 3 – k4, \*p3tog, k6\* repeat from \* to \* around to last 7 stitches, p3tog, k4 (37 stitches)

Row 4 - k3, \*k3tog, k4\* repeat from \* to \* around to last 6 stitches, k3tog, k3 (27 stitches)

Row 5 – k2, \*p3tog, k2\* repeat from \* to \* around to last 5 stitches, p3tog, k2 (17 stitches)

Row 6 - k1, k3tog five times, k1 (7 stitches)

Break yarn and thread through remaining stitches.

Sew together short edges with right sides together. Weave in ends.

If desired spray with starch to stiffen the star and /or add hanging loop.
