

## KNITTED ANGEL

You will need

a small quantity of DK yarn – any colour and a pair of 3mm needles

### Abbreviations

k – knit

k2tog – knit two together

kfb – knit into the front and back of the same stitch.

p- purl

p2tog – purl two together

### HEAD AND BODY

Cast on 36 stitches

Rows 1- 4 Knit

Row 5: (k2tog, k7) repeat 3 times, 32 sts.

Row 6: Purl

Row 7 and 8: Knit

Row 9: (k2tog, k6), repeat 3 times, 28 sts.

Row 10: Purl

Row 11 and 12: Knit

Row 13: (k2tog, k5), repeat 3 times, 24 sts.

Row 14: Purl

Row 15 and 16: Knit

Row 17: (k2tog, k4), repeat 3 times, 20 sts.

Row 18: Purl

Row 19 and 20: Knit

Row 21: (k2tog, k3), repeat 3 times, 16 sts.

Row 22: Purl

Row 23: (k2tog), repeat across row, 8 sts.

Row 24: Purl

Row 25: kfb in each st, 16 sts.

Rows 26 to 32: Starting with a purl row stocking stitch 7 rows.

Row 33: k2tog across row, 8 sts.

Row 34: p2tog across row, 4 sts.

Thread yarn through these 4 stitches and from the wrong side sew up the back seam. Put a little stuffing into the head of the angel and then sew a row of running stitches around the neck and pull tight.

### WINGS:

Cast on 21 sts on needle size 3 mm.

K 1 row

Then work short rows as follows: \*k7, turn and knit back, k1 row over all sts \*, repeat from \*to\* 6 times in total.

Then \*k2 tog, k6, turn and K back, k1 row over all sts \*, repeat from \*to\* until there are 15 sts on needle.

\*k2tog, k the rest of row \*, repeat from \*to\* until 9sts remain, cast off.

Sew wings to the back of the body with a line of stitches down the middle.
